Vestry Minutes January 14, 2018

A meeting of the vestry was held at the church following the service on January 14, 2018. The Annual Meeting was held today and went well.

The Annual Budget was presented and accepted as presented.

Vestry officers were nominated and elected. Jim Duffy - Sr. Warden, John Stugart - Jr. Warden, Margie Nevins - Treasurer, Janice Puleo - Secretary.

The minutes from the November 12th vestry meeting were presented. Revisions were made and the minutes were approved.

Senior Warden's report - Sallie Ann Buchanan thanked everyone for their help during this time of transition.

Treasurer's report - Margie questioned if Vestry wanted to send money received in Memorial for Paul Sojka to ECW for the light donated or leave the money in the Memorial fund. The vestry voted to leave the money in the Memorial fund. The ECW donated a light for the Clavinova in Paul's memory due to his love and assistance with the music in the church. The Treasurer's report was accepted as presented.

Steve Israel reported that we have about \$3800 in cash in the Raymond James account. We are generating cash through dividends. The finance committee will decide what stocks to reinvest in. The Vestry voted to approve this amendment of the Treasury Report.

The Junior Warden's Report was given by Jim Duffy. Two electrical outlets to be installed in the back of the Sanctuary. Jack to complete this work. LED lightbulbs for the sanctuary were ordered but weren't dimmable. New dimmable lights to be ordered.

Council meeting in February 16 & 17 and Nikki will attend. Pre-council meeting will be in Farmville on January 21st or 28th, 2018.

 needs paving and marking. Jim stated that if there was a substantial "outreach" project the Diocese may
 be willing to offer more money to assist.

Other Business

- Pancake supper? No request has been made to do this yet. Jim to contact Jack Richards and inquire if he
 is interested in doing this again. The Vestry discussed and voted to approve this function if Jack is
 interested in doing it.
- Margie suggested placing Germ-x in the pews and around the church to prevent spread of the flu. Janice
 will pick up the bottles and arrange placement in the church.
- Steve requested to refurbish an ambry to place in the church to hold extra sacraments and wine. The Vestry approved this. Steve to also get memorial plaques made for the items still needing plaques (i.e. fountain, light, statue, etc).
